Who is eligible?	Australian citizens Australian permanent residents
What does it cost?	Student contribution amount but ... \$23,000 living allowance (indexed, tax-free)
Post-graduate obligations?	Work for 6 years in a rural or remote area after completing GP or specialist training

BONDED MEDICAL PLACES (27)

Who is eligible?	Australian citizens Australian permanent residents
What does it cost?	Student contribution amount (no living allowance)
Post-graduate obligations?	Work for 4 years in an area of workforce shortage (outer metropolitan or rural) after completing GP or specialist training

Post-graduate obligations?	Work for 4 years in South Australia in an area of need (rural or metropolitan?)

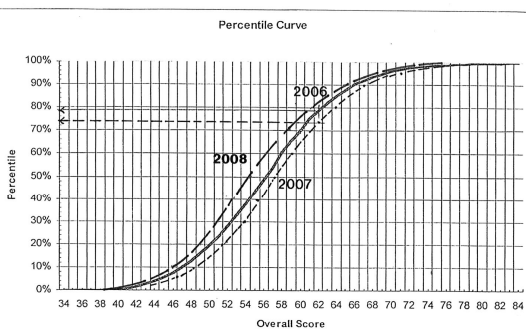
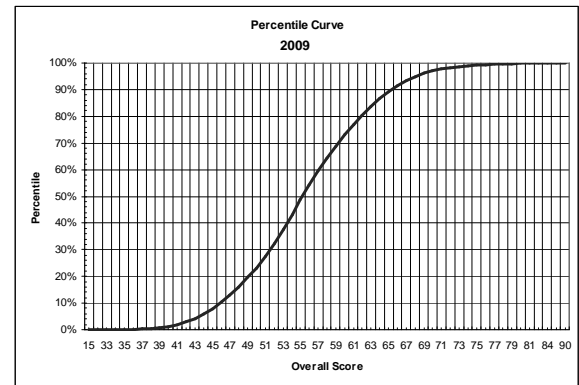
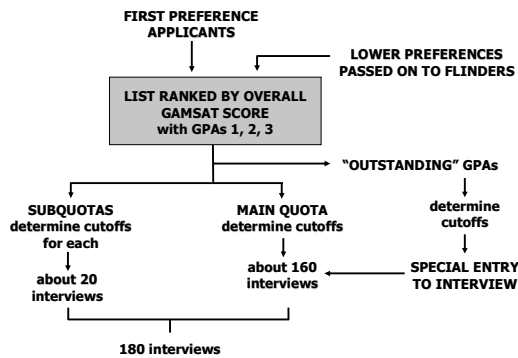
HOW THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS WILL WORK

- Applications
- Short listing for interview
- Interview
- Indicating preferences at interview time
- Process for sequential offers

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

- Complete on-line application and GPA calculations
- Indicate
 - sub-quota preference if relevant (documents required with application)
- Deadline for completion: 5:00 pm, Friday June 5, 2009
- Be sure to include email address, reliable to January
- Send acknowledgement and official transcript to GMAC Mulgrave Office (± extra subquota documents)

SELECTION FOR INTERVIEWS

- Identify about 180 for interview for 121 Australian places
 - Mainly on overall GAMSAT score (possible cut-off 55-60?)
likely Section minima: 50/ ~46/50
 - “special entry to interview”: outstanding GPA (6/7, 3 years) with lower GAMSAT (possible cut-off 54-57?)
 - [Enough South Australians for interview? (possible cut-off slightly lower, 54-57?)]
 - Notification about interviews, times and your confirmation of attendance will be on-line (start on web site front page)

INTERVIEWS

- At Flinders, September 22 – October 1
- About 50 minutes, panel of 2-3
- Some written scenarios (one to read pre-interview) plus other questions
- Communication skills
 - Decision-making
 - Learning style and team work
 - Supportive behaviour
 - Personal management skills
 - Quality of motivation

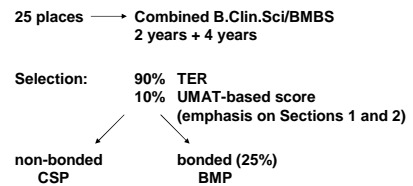
IDENTIFYING YOUR PREFERENCES PRIOR TO INTERVIEW TIME

- We will ask your order of preference for categories of place for which you are eligible
 - Non-bonded Commonwealth-supported
 - MRBS
 - SA-Government-supported (if available)
 - BMP
- This will determine the category of place offered
 - ie. the highest of your preferences for which you are competitive, given your place in the ranked list after interviews

RANKING AND OFFERS AFTER INTERVIEW

- RANKING BASED ON TOTAL OF
 - Overall GAMSAT
 - Weighted GPA
 - Interview score
- OFFERS SEQUENTIALLY DOWN RANKED LIST
 - Category of place offered determined by your place in the ranked list and, where relevant, your indicated order of preference
